Tilda, Tilda, Tilda, Tilda! We get four Tilda Swintons for the price of one in this camp cult sci-fi gem. In her initial incarnation Tilda is first and foremost Rosetta Stone, a bio-geneticist who uses her own DNA to breed three Self Replicating Automatons, part human, part computer named Ruby, Olive and Marinne (all played with wit and brio by Ms Swinton). The SRAs act as 'portals' on the Internet, helping users to fulfil their dreams. The SRAs are highly functional but dependent on some level of human touch and exchange of bodily fluids to survive. Being automatons they aren't really emotionally equipped to deal with relationships, so Rosetta tries to teach Ruby by projecting movie scenes onto her body which she absorbs as she sleeps. Add into the mix a computer virus-like condition that begins to afflict the SRA's paramours, some seriously lurid colour-coded visuals and Karen Black as 'Dirty Dick' a sexually ambiguous private detective. This is just about as quirky and maddeningly entertaining as science fiction gets. *Teknolust* may have a crazy heart, but it sure is a warm one too – Sarah Lutton, Associate Programmer The Created Woman
