

Broadway at Lakeside 2025 Outdoor screenings FAQs

What should I bring with me?

Please bring your booking confirmation ticket for admission. This can be shown on your mobile phone or as a printout. All guests listed on your ticket must arrive together. We advise bringing a torch as it will be dark when leaving the area. Please wear sensible footwear and dress appropriately for the weather. Seating will not be provided, so please bring camping chairs and/or picnic blankets.

Please note that tents and umbrellas are not allowed to ensure clear sightlines.

How do I get there?

Lakeside/Highfields Park is easily accessible by bus, tram, or car. We recommend using public transport where possible, but there are car parks available on a first-come, first-served basis for those driving. More information can be found on Lakeside's website.

What time does it start?

Please refer to the individual event page for each event's start time. The start time given is the time at which gates open to the public for the event, with the film itself starting once the sun goes down and conditions are dark enough.

What time does it finish?

The runtime or 'Duration' listed on each event page indicates the length of the film itself, and each film will begin when it is dark enough to screen.

What happens if the weather is bad?

The event will proceed, rain or shine. If you forget a blanket or waterproof, Broadway blankets and ponchos will be available for purchase. The event will only be cancelled if extreme weather makes conditions unsafe for attendees and staff. Please note that tickets are non-refundable and non-exchangeable.

Will there be food and drink available to buy?

Popcorn, sweets, and both alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages will be available for purchase during the evening. However, you are welcome to bring your own picnic. Please remember that all drinks and concessions purchased from Broadway help support our charitable mission to inspire creativity and a lifelong love of film. Thank you.

Can I drink alcohol at this event?

Attendees are welcome to drink alcohol at this event. However, both Broadway and Lakeside reserve the right to remove any individuals or groups who are disrupting the event and impacting other attendees' enjoyment. Please drink responsibly.

Are pets allowed?

Only assistance animals are allowed on the site. Is the event suitable for children? Please check the individual BBFC rating for your film if you're unsure whether it is suitable for your children. Please note that children must be supervised by their parent or guardian at all times.

Can I smoke at the event?

No. The site is strictly non-smoking, including vaping.
