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Edmond Rostand and his Cyrano de Bergerac

An excerpt from Sue Lloyd's The Man Who Was Cyrano, A Life Of Edmond Rostand.

Cyrano de Bergerac must be one of the best-known and best-loved plays in the world. It has been translated into almost every known language and inspired films, operas, musicals and even ballet.

Edmond Rostand was born in 1868 to prosperous and cultured parents in the southern French city of Marseilles. When he was received into the Académie française in 1903, he told the audience: 'We need a theatre where, inspiring us with beauty, consoling us with grace, poets, without doing it deliberately, give us lessons for the soul'. 'And this is why', he insisted, 'we need dramas that are not only poetic but also heroic!' because 'only a hero, someone larger than life, can take us out of ordinary life and return us to it refreshed and invigorated'.

By the time he wrote *Cyrano de Bergerac*, Rostand was already an accomplished dramatist. But in December 1897 the success of *Cyrano de Bergerac* was far from certain. Verse plays were normally performed at the Comédie-Française. However, by the time of Cyrano's duel with Valvert in Act One, the audience was completely enthralled. At the next performance, Rostand was decorated with the Legion of Honour, he had suddenly become a celebrity.
